- Dr. R.K.Bhandari, Banarsidas Chandiwala Institute of Hotel Management & Catering Technology (BHMCT)

The following discussions were held:

- (1) It was indicated that the curriculum revision has to be taken up for implementation from the Academic Session 2021-22. The new curriculum should attempt to incorporate the following features to make it contemporary and in line with the provisions of NEP 2020 such as multi entry and multi exit, 3 years, 4 years programme at undergraduate level, skill based courses etc.
 - · Choice based credit system
 - Provision for online course through MOOC, SWAYAM etc.
 - Open electives
 - Bilingual teaching
 - All curriculums should be prepared with clearly identified program outcomes, program specific outcomes, course outcomes and their mapping.
 - Mechanism for measurement of objectives for each course.
 - · Courses on Human Values, Entrepreneurship, Environmental science, etc.
- Further, it was decided that the respective programme coordinators will conduct their own meetings with all the colleges/institutes conducting the programmes. A draft scheme would be prepared and shared latest by 28th December, 2020. In this regard, USMS will provide all possible help through their Professors to guide and mentor the Programme Coordination Committee. It was also agreed that feed back collected by the School from various colleges/institutes regarding the curriculum changes will also be shared with all the Coordinators of Programme Coordination Committee of various programmes. The entire exercise of curriculum revision should be completed by the end of January 2021.

The Committee should look into the best practices in curriculum along with any UGC guidelines/model courses, adopted by various institutes both nationally and internationally while working-out the scheme. The scheme should also clearly identify/classify the course as skill based interdisciplinary, electives etc.

The meeting ended with the vote of thanks to the Chair.

This was a follow up of the meeting of the faculty members of USMS held on 31.3.2021 at 3:30 P.M. Chairperson welcomes all the members to the meeting and expressed gratitude for the hard work done all the Chairpersons and the Coordinators in the curriculum revision. The discussions and recommendation are as follows:

- It was decided that the course curriculum has to be prepared for BBA including Allied Areas such (1) BBA (CAM), BBA (B&I) and B.Com as a three year programmes and MBA as a two year programm
- The number of credits offered and credits required for the award of degree in BBA and all (2)subjects as well as B.Com should be kept uniform.
- The UGC prescribed total 148 credits to be offered and minimum 140 credits are required for aw (3) for degree. The same credit scheme is decided to be implemented for all the BBA & B.Com.
- The disciplinary electives should be offered in all the BBA and B.Com programme. (4)
- Two open electives should be offered in all the programs as per the decision of the Acade (5)Council resolution number.
- Under elective courses there can be two categories: (6)

Generic Elective Course (a)

Discipline Specific Elective Course (b)

- (7) Ability Enhancement Course can be of two types of
- (a) Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course.
- (8) For BBA and B.Com programme the following distribution of courses was decided:
- (a) Core papers 14 nos. of 4 credit each
- (b) Discipline Specific Elective Course- 4 nos. (1 in 4th Semester, 2 in 5th Semester and 1 in 6 Semester).
- (c) Open Electives to be offered from semester II onwards to be pursued online as per the choice of tl student and in accordance with the open electives guidelines of the University. The result of su elective course shall be submitted by the student to the University -2 nos. of 02 credits each.
- (d) Project Courses:
 - Minor Project 4 credits (2nd semester)
 - Summer Training Report 6 credits (5th Semester)
 - Major Project 6 credits (6th Semester).

The Sixth Semester project should follow plagiarism policy of the UGC.

- (e) Yoga/Entrepreneurial Mind Set/NSS etc.- 2 credits to be offered under Ability Enhanceme Compulsory Course.
- (f) Skill Enhancement Course cover the Data Analytics, Professional Skills, Information/Lite Schemes/Problem Solving Skills, Communication Skills etc. courses should be included 2 nos. o credits each.

For All MBA programmes

- (9) For MBA programme it was decided that we should follow the above guidelines with the provisi that the student is required to option 105 credits out of 112 to be offered in the Scheme.
 - (a) The provision should be made for Dual electives with four elective courses in the 3rd and semester.
 - (b) Each all the core courses should be 3 credits instead of 4 credits.
