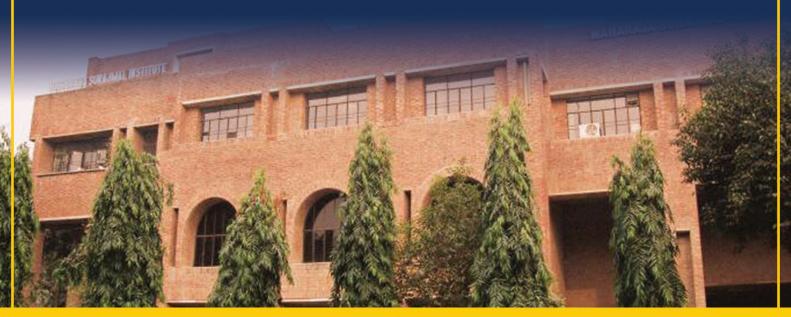

- Paper should be typed in Ms-Word in standard format with maximum 6 pages.
- Paper must include an informative title, name(s), address (es), email id(s), contact no(s) of all authors and affiliations in Times New Roman 14 (only authors bold) written at the top.
- · The paper must include an abstract of about 150 words and maximum of five keywords related to the topic of the paper.

Paper must include introduction, survey of literature, proposed work, result, conclusions and reference section.

- Paper size: A4
- Margins: Left 1.5", Right 1", Top 1" and Bottom 1"
- Font Style: Times New Roman, Single Spacing in two columns.
- Font Size: Title 14 (Bold), Name of Authors and affiliations 12, Sub-heading 12 (Bold), Abstract 9 (Bold) [Max. 150 words], Paper Text 11, References 10
- Format: The paper should be typed in MS-Word document.
- · All charts, graphs, pictures should be drawn and labeled legibly as "figure 1", "figure 2", etc.
- Captions of the charts, graphs, pictures should be complete enough to allow appreciation of the illustration without referring to the text.
- For the final selection, all the papers will be reviewed and scrutinized by a Technical Committee comprising of subject experts.
- Information about necessary revisions will be communicated to the corresponding author through e-mail.
- The author(s) will have to strictly incorporate the suggestions and will have to send the revised camera ready copy of the paper in the given time limit.
- Authors of the accepted papers will be informed through e-mail.
- Book & Certificate will be sent by post.
- All the accepted papers would be published as edited book with ISBN No. with Reputed Publisher. Few selected papers may be published in the journal with ISSN No.
