MSI organized numerous activities during Academic Year 2021-2022 that included more than 130 activities for the students and faculty.

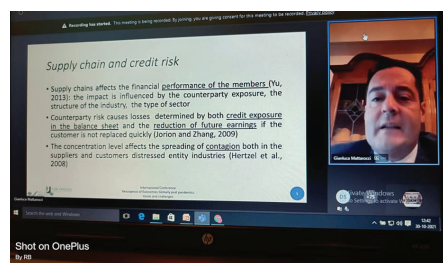
Two Days International Conference on “Resurgence of Economies Globally Post Pandemic: Issues and Challenges”

Blood Donation Camp



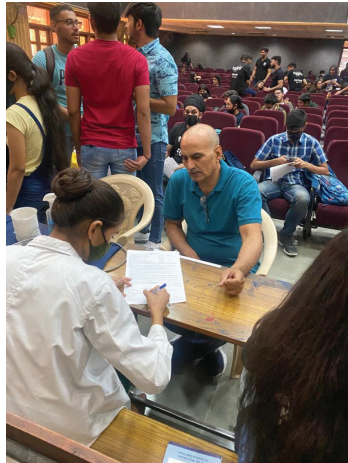

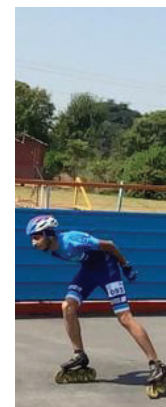

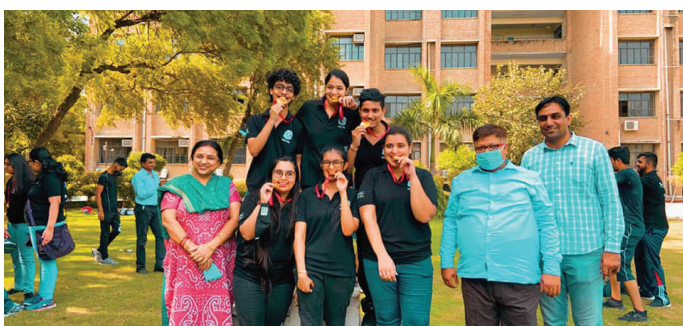
